SISA MEMBERS CALL TO ACTION Lake Lowell – Deer Flat Wildlife Refuge

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service has released preliminary management alternatives for the Deer Flat Refuge. There are four alternatives. Public comments are being accepted through July 29, 2011. The Southern Idaho Sailing Association only supports Alternative 1, which maintains the "status quo" of Lake Lowell. Alternatives 2 to 4 do not allow for sailing regattas on Lake Lowell. **U.S. Fish and Wildlife is proposing to ban sailing regattas on Lake Lowell.** The latest communications from USFWS have been uploaded to the SISA website: http://www.idahosailing.org/lake_lowell_changes. Sailing Instructions Modifications

The 2011 General Sailing Instructions for SISA have been modified with addition of the following:

5. SCORING AND AWARDS

5.1

OCS (on course start) all boats starting, plus 1 point

RAF (retired after finish) all boats starting, plus 1 point

Both OCS and RAF can be thrown out. An OCS is used when a boat is over early but continues to race rather than re-start. This is often the case when a boat does not realize they are over early.

An RAF could be used when, for example, a boat sailed the wrong course and there was no foul to another boat. Skippers must notify the race committee as soon after the finish of the race as safely possible, of their intent to retire after finish.

5.7 CASCADE CUP ONLY. For the annual Cascade Cup regatta, no throw-outs will be allowed.

**North Beach Rendezvous
Payette Lake, McCall
August 13-14, 2011**

On August 13-14, we'll be having a sailing rendezvous at North Beach on Payette Lake in McCall. North Beach is one of the most beautiful beaches in Idaho. This is a SISA and Mill Harbor Yacht Club combined event. On Saturday, Aug. 13, the Mill Harbor folks will start to arrive around 6 pm on Saturday. The SISA folks can arrive any time on Saturday. A potluck will be held at 7 pm. Bring your meat to grill and a dish or dessert to share.

We've been granted a special use permit to have our event at North Beach after dark for Saturday night (Aug. 13) only. If you are going to sleep overnight at North Beach, one can only sleep on your boat. Overnight camping is NOT permitted on the beach nor in any of the parking lots on North Beach nor across the river at the North Beach boat ramp day-use area. Camping is only permitted on your boat.

There are 2 ways to attend this event: by car or by boat. If you attend by car, you can park in the North Beach parking lot. If you plan to stay after dusk, I recommend you park on the road.

If you attend by boat, you may sleep on your boat. Most boats staying overnight will anchor bow-out with a stern line tied to shore (tied to a tree). I recommend your anchor has a least 100 feet of line as it must grab the underwater shelf that drops off. The Valley County Marine Sheriff requires all boats sleeping overnight to have an anchor light. It does not have to be on the top of the mast. The light must be visible at least 36 inches above the highest point of your cabin. One does not need a fancy anchor light. I use a portable 12 volt anchor light like the one shown below and hoist it up about 4 feet or so above the cabin. Or, you can use an LED lantern and just hoist it up.
