CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR NEW LEADERSHIP!

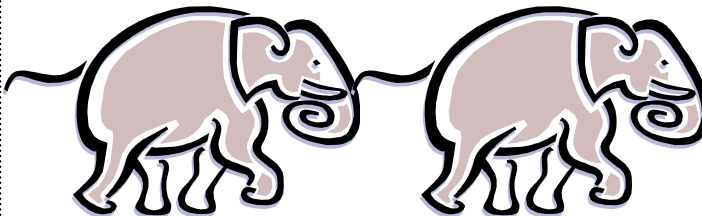

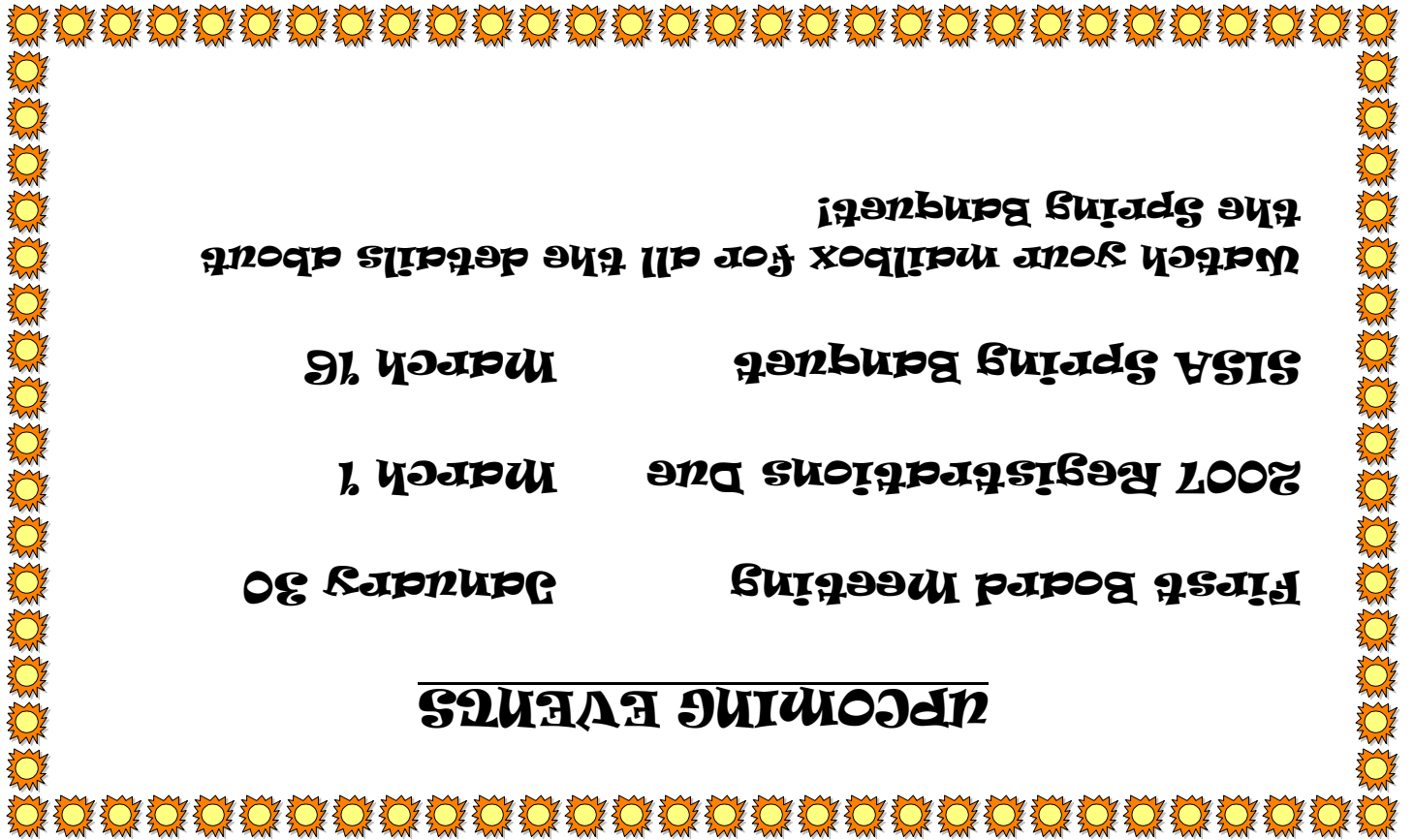
